Welcome to the University of Nevada, School of Medicine (UNSOM). As our incoming interns for 2009-2010, we need to gather the most important information needed for creating our yearly schedule – when you want your vacation!

**VACATION:** You will have fifteen (15) working days off as vacation each year, broken into a one week block (five [5] working days) and a two week block (ten [10] working days). Vacations cannot “straddle” two different blocks. Please review the block list provided to determine your preference for vacation weeks. If you would like to select a specific time period for vacation, please indicate the dates in your request (e.g. Oct 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>) or you may choose specific weeks (e.g. week two of block four). Please note that each block begins on a Monday, so a request for the first week of a block as vacation **will not** include the prior weekend. Otherwise, requests will include the weekend before and after as continuous vacation time, unless specific dates are chosen that do not run from Monday to Friday.

Every attempt will be made to grant your top priority, however the vacation requests will be reviewed on a first come-first serve basis. **Final determination of vacation is binding!** Any request for changes must be provided in writing a minimum of **three (3) months in advance.**

**PRELIMINARY RESIDENTS:** Please note that your one week vacation block will be assigned to the last five working days of June 2009, in order to allow time for moving and for orientation into your new program. You may choose your two week block otherwise.

**PGY1 SICK LEAVE:** As a PGY1 resident you will begin residency with fifteen (15) days of sick leave available for use upon starting residency.

**PGY2/3/4 SICK LEAVE:** As a PGY2/3/4 your sick leave is accrued at a rate of 1.25 days per month for a total of fifteen (15) days per year.

**ALL PGY:** The maximum amount of sick time you can have accrued at one time is no more than fifteen (15) days.

**FMLA:** The Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) of 1993 enables an *eligible* staff member to take up to 12 weeks of unpaid, job-protected leave in a 12-month period for specified FMLA qualifying reasons. PGY1 (including Preliminary) residents who take a leave of absence *are not* protected under the FMLA due to FMLA Leave minimum requirement of 12 months of continuous full time employment to be eligible.

**PARENTAL LEAVE:** (Maternity/Paternity leave) A resident is allowed to use sick leave up to fifteen (15) days and an additional fifteen (15) days of vacation (total of six [6] weeks absence) without loss of pay for pregnancy, adoption and subsequent newborn care.
