EXTREMITIES/ SKIN:

- careful inspection of skin to include accurate verbal description of any skin/nail changes
- comments on muscle bulk, atrophy or any signs of physical trauma
- check for peripheral pulses
- accurately assesses cyanosis / capillary refill
- can identify signs of chronic peripheral vascular disease
- demonstration of ability to perform Homan's test
- palpation of joints, checking for effusions
- testing for knee joint stability
- can accurately describe any joint abnormality
- testing for sciatic irritation (SLR)
- assesses for edema and accurately rates it (if present)
- can identify clubbing?

NEUROLOGIC EXAM:

- knows how to perform mini-mental status examination
- comments on any abnormal movement disorders
- cranial nerve testing
- deep tendon reflexes
- cerebellar testing
- evaluates gait appropriately
- accurately rates muscle strength
- comments on muscle tone / recognizes spasticity / rigidity
- plantar reflex
- appropriate sensory examination (pain, microfilament, temperature)
- can identify signs of cauda equina syndrome, and how to test for it
- proprioception testing

- prostate/ rectal examination
- inguinal hernia testing
- scrotal examination
- breast examination
- pelvic speculum exam (including labial exam)
- bimanual palpation of cervix. ovaries, uterus
