

ELECTIVE EVALUATIONS AND FINAL GRADES

All evaluations of UNSOM elective courses are now scheduled into the E*Value on-line data collection program. At the beginning of each UNSOM elective course, students must contact the Office of Medical Education (Scheduler) to confirm the dates of the elective course and name(s) of the preceptor(s). Students may send this information in an email to: unsomevaluation@medicine.nevada.edu. Students who do not provide this information may not have their elective grades posted in a timely manner for purposes of residency application and/or graduation.

Students will be prompted to evaluate their elective preceptors and the elective course itself by email through the E*Value program. UNSOM elective preceptors, whenever possible, should also submit their evaluations of fourth year students through the E*Value program and they will also receive email reminders at the end of each elective course.

Students are responsible for providing their preceptors at other institutions with a hard copy Final Evaluation form that should be filled out at the end of the elective course and then submitted to UNSOM so that a final grade can be recorded and credit given. Some institutions/preceptors will use their own forms to submit final grades. Please discuss this with your preceptor before completing your out-of-state electives. All fourth year students will receive an electronic copy of the Final Elective evaluation form from OME in early July. You must make copies of this form and distribute them to all your out-of-state elective preceptors.
